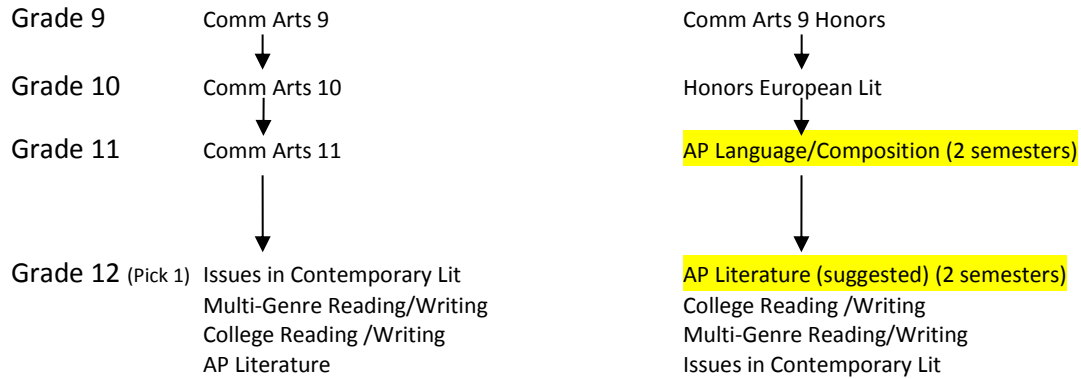

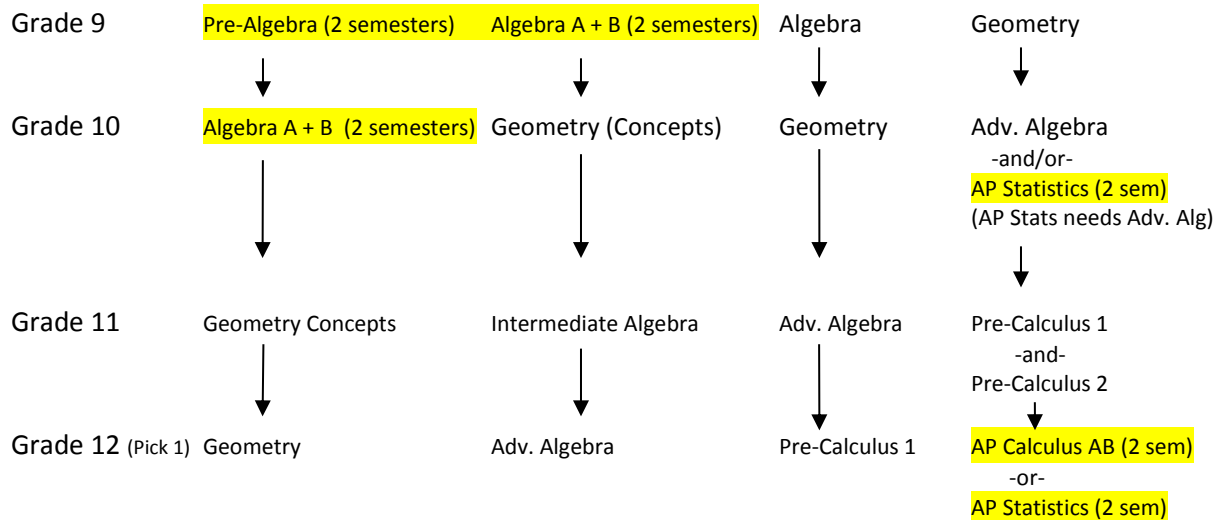

Course Flow Chart

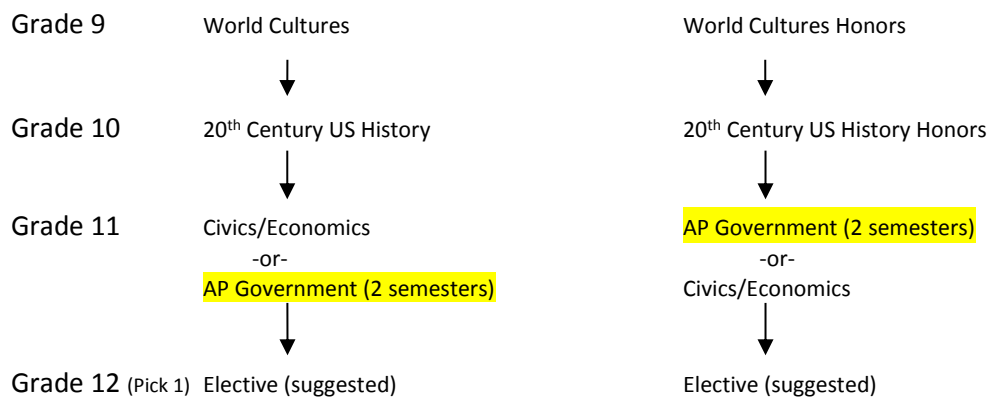

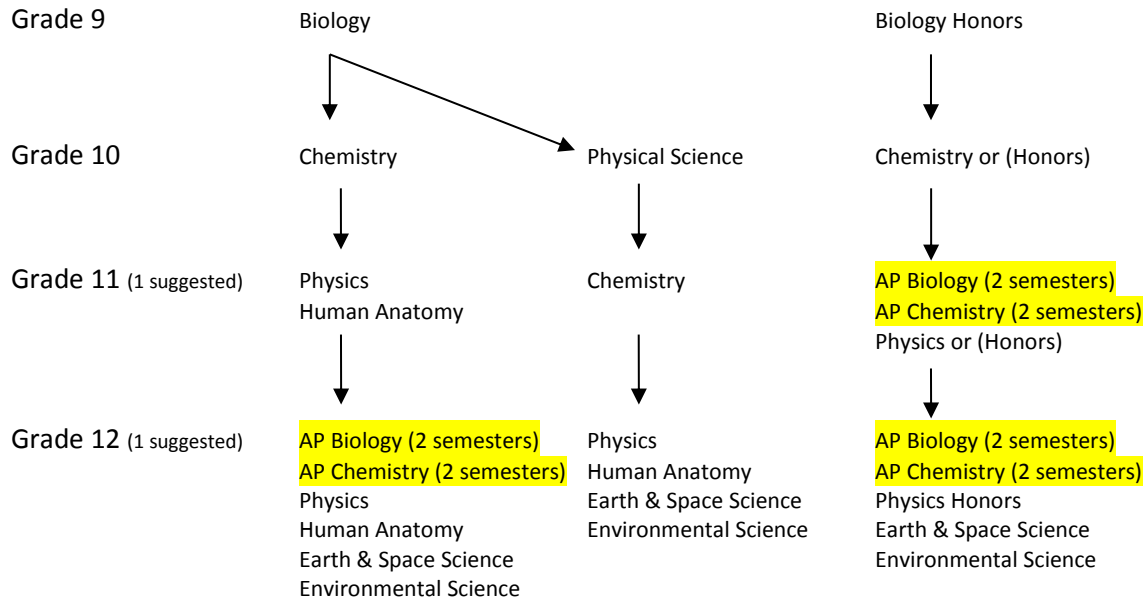

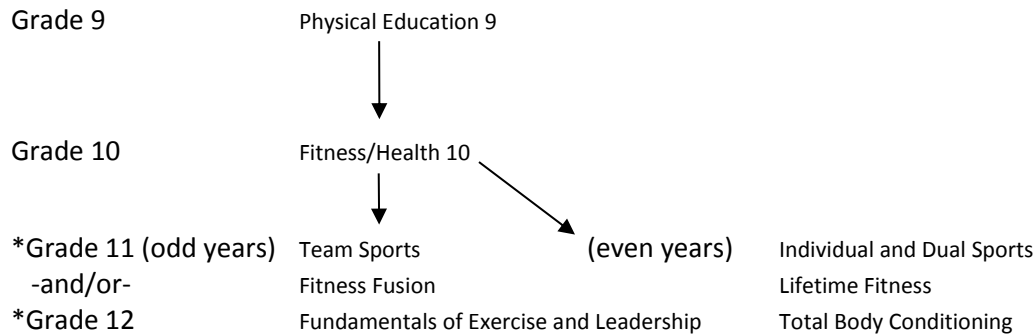
