Seniors who have received scholarships from any college or organization are asked to bring their letter of confirmation to Guidance. We want to recognize you at the ceremony! Beginning the first week of May, invitations to the Senior Scholarship Ceremony will be sent to all those from whom we have received confirmation of receiving a scholarship.

The Dream Pool Foundation, Inc. is offering the **Carrie Crystal Stuckert Memorial Scholarships** to provide assistance to individuals pursuing a degree in the visual arts. Academically capable students must be enrolled as an Art Major at an accredited institution of higher education in the U.S. This includes Art Therapy Programs. They are offering two \$2,000 and three \$1,000 scholarships. Interested candidates must possess extra-curricular accomplishments and inspirational goals.
