Forward Testing has begun...

Wisconsin Forward Exam testing at Templeton will be from April 16-26. Students in sixth, seventh and eighth grade will take the English Language Arts (ELA) and mathematics tests. Eighth grade students will also take the science and social studies tests. During Templeton's testing window, we would appreciate if parents could please refrain from taking students out of school for appointments, meeting, vacations, etc.

- Grade 6 will test on April 16 & 23.
- Grade 7 will test on April 17 & 24.
- Grade 8 will test on April 18, 19, 25 & 26.

Standardized tests such as the Forward Exam provide important student achievement information. Your child's test results, classroom assessments, work products and teacher feedback provide a comprehensive picture of your child's learning.
