Attention: Freshmen/Sophomores

Are you interested in developing leadership skills and becoming more involved in the community? You should apply for the *Falls Sussex Youth Leadership*. This is a program designed to provide first-hand exposure to business, government, and volunteer aspects within the Falls/Sussex communities. You will gain valuable insight and skills in community leadership. The application is for the 2018-19 school year. Deadline is TODAY. Applications are in Guidance. Sign up early as there are only a limited number of spaces.

Shire US Inc. is sponsoring an ADHD scholarship to students who have been diagnosed with ADHD and are under the care of a licensed health care professional. This scholarship offers a one-time tuition payment of \$2,000 and also includes ADHD coaching services by the Edge Foundation with an approximate value of \$4,400. 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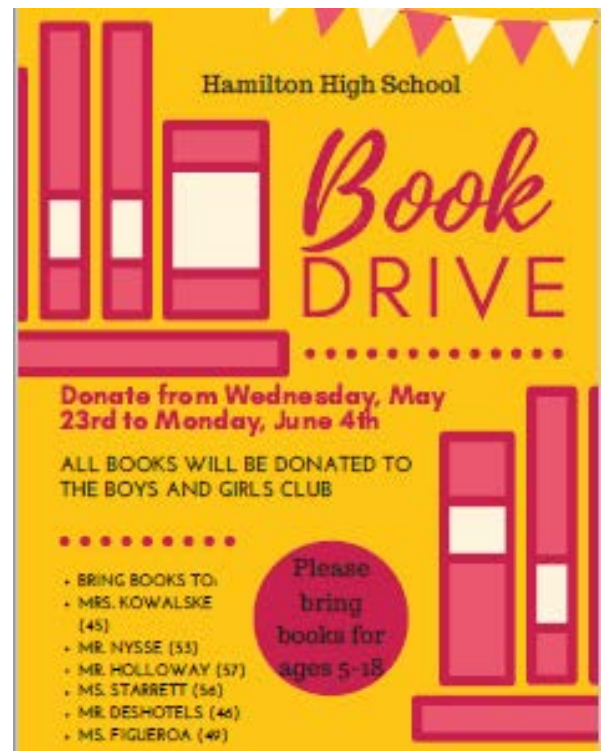
