Online Registration and Pictures, Locks, and Parking Day for 2018-19 August 1-7

In preparation for the 2018-19 school year, HHS families are required to complete Online Registration Verification, pay fees (through Infinite Campus) and students are required to attend Pictures, Locks, and Parking Day. Hamilton High School families will be able to register online for the 2018-19 school year through Infinite Campus from August 1 through August 7. **Attendance at Pictures, Locks, and Parking Day (Tuesday, August 7 from 1-6 PM or Wednesday, August 8 from 7-9 AM) is required for all students (even seniors) to get their school id picture taken, buy locks, and pick up parking permits.** Online registration verification is designed to streamline processes for current and new students. Families with children already enrolled in the district will log into the Infinite Campus Parent Portal. New families will access registration functions through a link on the district website. Parents will be able to update demographic, health and emergency contact information as well as complete annual forms. **As in the past, parents should pay fees online. There is NO additional charge for online payment.** Parents can expect an email this summer with specific information on the registration process, which will open August 1. Parents who do not have an active Infinite Campus Parent Portal account can get assistance by contacting campushelp@hamilton.k12.wi.us. Information Technology staff members will respond to requests for help weekdays until 4:30 PM. Help desk support is not available nights and weekends.
