

## **Welcome to Hamilton High School's Driver Education 2018-19**

Hamilton's Driver Education is a foundation course with the emphasis on the knowledge and application of becoming a good safe driver. The first 21 students signed up that are 15 years old or older will be in the class.

There are three phases of Driver Education at Hamilton:

\***Theory phase 2:45-4:45** improves student knowledge of the rules of the road and traffic safety, study the financial obligations of owning an automobile, accident prevention and the effects of alcohol and other drugs on driving. (15 classes) **First day of class will be Tuesday, Sept. 6.** Our class will meet on **Tues., Wed. and Thursday** for 15 classes (Sept. 6, 11, 12, 13, 18, 19, 20, Oct. 2, 4, 9, 10, 11, 23, 24, 25),

\***Simulation phase**-2 hours- simulated driving experiences of residential, rural and freeway driving, winter and snow, hazards in the road, flat tires, split second decisions and collision avoidance. (5 lessons) We will make up our groups in class. Schedules will be made out in class to accommodate car poolers and job schedules. One Sim. Group will start on Monday, Sept. 24 at 2:45-4:45. There will be 3 Sim groups. We will pick these groups in class. Anyone carpooling will stay together.

\***Behind-the-Wheel**- Students must have their temps to drive- six different driving lessons on the road in a 2017 car. Residential turns, Y-turns, backing up along the curb, rural roads, up and down hill parking, intersections, lane changes, Milwaukee intersections, expressway driving-getting on and off, lane changes and parallel parking. (6 lessons in our Ewald - 2017 Chevy) *Pick up and drop off at Hamilton High School. Lessons are after school or Sat. mornings – lessons are 2 hrs. ea.*

**We start class on Thursday, September 6, 2018.** **Bring a pen or pencil to every class.** We do not take a break during class. Be on time 2:45-4:45 pm. We will not meet on Wednesday, October 3 of Homecoming week. You may bring water/soda/juice to class. The Theory phase meets on Tues-Wed-Thurs. at 2:45. If you have any questions- email me or give me a call. The fee for the class is \$175 and BTW is \$175. If you need the Infinite Campus option let me know.

Let's hope you wear your seat belt and be ready to drive safely.

Theory and BTW are required by state law for everyone under 16 years of age.

Students must be enrolled in Driver Ed and be 15 ½ prior to obtaining an Instructional Permit.

Students must be 16 by December 31 to enroll in the total program.

(We will go over the rules and laws prior to getting their "Temps")

## RULES:

1. Attendance is mandatory to meet state mandates and pass the course. Theory meets Tue-Wed-Thurs = 15 classes, no class the Wed. of Homecoming week. Last Theory class Oct. 25, make up class Oct. 26.
2. Thirty clock hours of Theory, ten hours of Simulation and twelve hours of Behind-the-Wheel are required to obtain a completion form with the Hamilton High School Program.
3. If attendance falls below state mandates, the student will be dropped from the program without a refund.
4. The first 21 students signed up for the program and are 15 years or older will be in the class.
5. Temporary Permit forms will be handed out in class after going through the rules and laws of the road. Students must be 15 ½ to obtain an Instructional Permit.
