When the Guidance Office receives scholarship information, it is added to the HHS Scholarship List. This list can be found on the HHS website by clicking on Guidance Resources and looking at the "Find It Fast" section on the bottom left side. There are also scholarship opportunities outside of what is available on the Hamilton Scholarship List. But, be careful! There are also scholarship scams out there. The Federal Trade Commission warns against organizations that "guarantee" scholarships and require a fee.
