## Early College Credit Program and Start College Now

Students interested in taking college courses Fall Semester 2019 must complete the ECCP application or Start College Now application (for WCTC) located on our Guidance Webpage. All forms must be completed and turned in to Guidance by Thursday, 2/28. There are no exceptions to this deadline as it is set by state legislation.

Hamilton High School has again partnered with **Community Memorial Hospital** to offer the **Healthcare Career Academy** in the summer of 2019. The Healthcare Career Academy provides qualified students with the opportunity to expand their knowledge base as it relates to a wide array of professional healthcare options. Students need to be entering their junior or senior year in the fall of 2019. The Healthcare Career Academy experience will provide each student with a well-balanced approach towards healthcare career exposure. This exposure will assist with clarifying roles and responsibilities while motivating students and encouraging healthcare career choices.
