The PSAT is the only route of entry into the National Merit Scholarship Competition (NMSC) for Juniors and may be required for some other scholarships. Interested Juniors can now register in Student Services. Sophomores can register for the test beginning Friday, September 20 on a first-come, first-served basis. The \$17 test fee is payable at the time of registration. Stop in Student Services to register and for more information.
