When signing up for an activity please note the eligibility requirements (per Student Handbook):

Eligibility Standards for Co-Curricular Activities

Academic excellence and achievement is the primary goal of every student at TMS. While participating in co-curricular activities is very beneficial, the following are eligibility criteria. A student must:

- *be in regular attendance and be enrolled at Templeton Middle School.*

- *regularly attend classes and not receive a grade of U in any class.*

If a student is doing unsatisfactory work (grade of U) in one or more subjects:

a) The student will be declared ineligible based on the previous grading period.
(progress reports or report cards)

b) In the event that a student receives a U during progress report time or the final grading period for the quarter, that student has two weeks (10 school days) to prove eligibility. During that time a student may practice with the athletic team or Robotics team, but not compete in games/competitions. For all other clubs and activities, the student may not participate until eligibility is proven. If he or she remains ineligible after 10 days, the student will be dismissed from the club, team, or activity.
