

WOODSIDE LUNCH PROGRAM

Lunch Prices (subject to change)

Elementary Student: Daily \$3.05 (includes milk)

Elementary Adult: \$4.50 (includes milk)

Students who bring a cold lunch may purchase milk using their lunch card or they may bring \$.50 cash.

What's for Lunch?

The current lunch menu can be found on the Hamilton School District website. This menu is interactive and contains nutrition and allergen information.

School Lunch Visitors

We welcome parents and other family members (maximum two people) to join a child for lunch. An ID is required for each person entering the building. A parent or guardian must contact the office prior to 8:45 a.m. to notify the school and/or order a school lunch. Please call the school office at (262) 820-1530.

How Does the System Work?

Each student has a lunch card with a unique and secure lunch barcode number. As students go through the lunch line, they will scan their barcode cards at the checkout. The purchase price is subtracted from the total account balance. To ensure the proper charge to a student account, photo verification of each child is made at the time of purchase.

Lunch Account Balance

Parents may obtain lunch account balances via the Infinite Campus parent portal. In addition, households will receive an automated phone call when a student's balance is \$11 or less. Please note that phone calls may continue to be received for up to 24 hours after a deposit is made to an account.

Two Ways to Pay

1. Via Infinite Campus Parent Portal

Deposits can be made to your child's lunch account via the Infinite Campus parent portal using the Payment tab. An electronic transfer of money is made from your bank account or major credit cards are also accepted. A recurring payment option is available and must be renewed annually. There are no service fees for these transactions.

2. Check or Cash

A check made payable to Hamilton School District or cash (enclosed in a sealed envelope) may be sent to the school office. To ensure that your child's money is deposited correctly, please clearly mark the student's full name on each check or envelope.

Free or Reduced Lunch Program

Parents who have children eligible for participation in the federal free or reduced lunch program should complete an application form via online registration or the district website.

Applications are accepted anytime during the school year. Applications from the previous school year expire in mid-September and must be completed at the start of the next school year to keep benefits current. Online application is highly encouraged to expedite this process. Strict confidentiality is assured with this program.

PLEASE NOTE: Although a free or reduced lunch includes milk, if a student chooses to bring a cold lunch instead of eating hot lunch, he or she must pay for milk separately.
