LAUDE SYSTEM INFORMATION

Beginning with the Class of 2028

The Laude System acknowledges student achievement through a combination of cumulative GPA and number of advanced courses completed (with a minimum grade of 'C') in their high school career as calculated at the end of the 7th semester.

- Cum Laude** (with distinction) 3.0 or higher cumulative GPA with at least 4 advanced courses
- Magna Cum Laude** (with great distinction) 3.5 or higher cumulative GPA with at least 6 advanced courses
- Summa Cum Laude** (with highest distinction) 3.75 - 4.00+ cumulative GPA with at least 8 advanced course credits

ACT 95 INFORMATION

All HHS Students

This new law requires every Wisconsin public high school to rank the GPA of students at the end of their junior year. Students ranking in the top 5% of each WI high school will receive guaranteed admission to the University of Wisconsin - Madison. Students in the top 10% of each WI high school will receive direct admission into all other schools in the University of Wisconsin System.
